

RING BELL**PURPOSE**

Rings the bell (immediately) on all the currently active graphics devices.

DESCRIPTION

Some devices, particularly off-line devices, do not support this option. The RING BELL command is intended for terminals. It is typically used to notify the analyst that DATAPLOT has completed some action.

SYNTAX

RING BELL <number>

where <number> is an integer number or parameter that specifies the number of times to ring the bell.

EXAMPLES

RING BELL
RING BELL 3

NOTE

RING BELL with no arguments is equivalent to RING BELL 1.

DEFAULT

None

SYNONYMS

None

RELATED COMMANDS

ERASE	=	Erases the screen (immediately).
BELL	=	Sets the automatic bell switch for plots.
PRE-ERASE	=	Sets the automatic pre-erase switch for plots.
HARDCOPY	=	Sets the automatic copy switch for plots.
SEQUENCE	=	Sets the automatic sequence switch for plots.
