

ON**PURPOSE**

Sets the DATAPLOT switch in question to the “on” position.

DESCRIPTION

The off position typically means that the requested feature will not appear. For example, X2TIC MARK ON means that the tic marks on the upper x axis will appear on subsequent plots.

SYNTAX

<Certain commands> ON

EXAMPLES

ECHO ON
FRAME ON
TICS ON
X2TICS ON
TIC LABELS ON
X2TIC LABELS ON
FEEDBACK ON
GRID ON
LOGLOG ON

DEFAULT

SYNONYMS

RELATED COMMANDS

OFF	=	Allows switches to be set to “off.”
DEFAULT	=	Allows switches to be set to “default.”
AUTOMATIC	=	Allows switches to be set to “automatic.”
