

**VISIBLE**

## NOTE

\*\*\*\*\* This command is not currently operational \*\*\*\*\*

## PURPOSE

Specifies whether or not “hidden lines” will be visible on subsequent 3-dimensional plots generated with the 3D-PLOT command.

## SYNTAX

VISIBLE <ON or OFF>

where ON specifies that hidden lines will be visible while OFF specifies that they will not be visible.

## EXAMPLES

VISIBLE ON  
VISIBLE OFF  
VISIBLE

## NOTE

The VISIBLE command with no arguments is equivalent to the VISIBLE ON command.

## DEFAULT

Hidden lines will be visible.

## SYNONYMS

None

## RELATED COMMANDS

3D-PLOT	=	Generates a 3-d data or function plot.
EYE COORDINATES	=	Sets the eye location for 3-d plots.
