

**SET IPR****PURPOSE**

Define the unit used for alphanumeric output.

**DESCRIPTION**

This unit is generally set by the local installer to be the terminal screen by default, so the analyst typically does not need to modify its value. Although changing this value can be used to redirect the alphanumeric output to a file rather than the screen, the `CAPTURE` command is the recommended way to do this.

**SYNTAX**

`SET IPR <unit number>`

where <unit number> is an integer number or parameter in the range 1 to 99 that identifies the Fortran unit number where alphanumeric output will be printed.

**EXAMPLES**

`SET IPR 10`

`SET IPR 6`

**DEFAULT**

The terminal screen. This is unit 6 on most computer systems.

<code>SET IRD</code>	=	Set the unit for alphanumeric input.
<code>CAPTURE</code>	=	Redirect alphanumeric output to a file.
