

SET IRD**PURPOSE**

Define the unit used for alphanumeric input.

DESCRIPTION

This unit is generally set by the local installer to be the terminal by default, so the analyst typically does not need to modify its value. Although changing this value can be used to read commands from a file, the CALL command is the recommended way to do this.

SYNTAX

SET IRD <unit number>

where <unit number> identifies the Fortran unit number where commands will be read.

EXAMPLES

SET IRD 10

SET IRD 5

DEFAULT

The terminal. This is unit 5 on most computer systems.

SYNONYMS

RELATED COMMANDS

SET IPR	=	Set the unit for alphanumeric output.
CAPTURE	=	Redirect alphanumeric output to a file.
CALL	=	Execute commands stored in a file.
