

NLIST

PURPOSE

Generate a list with line numbers.

DESCRIPTION

This command can be useful for things such as seeing how many header lines need to be skipped at the beginning of a data file.

SYNTAX 1

NLIST <filename>
where <file name> is the file to list.

SYNTAX 2

NLIST <filename> FOR I = <start> <inc> <stop>
where <file name> is the file to list;
<start> specifies the first line to list;
<inc> specifies the increment between lines (this is almost always 1);
and <stop> specifies the last row to list.

EXAMPLES

```
NLIST PLOTCAL.DP
NLIST PLOTCAL.DAT FOR I = 1 1 25
```

RELATED COMMANDS

LIST	=	List the contents of a file without line numbers.
SKIP	=	Specify the number of lines to skip at the beginning of a data file.
ROW LIMITS	=	Specify which rows to read in a data file.
