

**PROBE****PURPOSE**

Dumps (prints out) the contents of certain internal underlying Fortran variables.

**DESCRIPTION**

This command provides information which may assist in implementation and debugging. Hence it is normally only used by the service group which implements DATAPLOT on your computer.

**SYNTAX**

PROBE <name>

where <name> is the underlying Fortran variable to print.

**EXAMPLES**

PROBE NUMCOL

PROBE NUMNAM

PROBE IBUGSU

**NOTE**

The list of the variables that can be probed is documented under the SET command. See the chapter for the SET subcommands.

**DEFAULT**
